FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS!

I'm interested in a Doula, where do I start?

- The first step is to set up a brief phone call (15min) with agency owner Tara Campbell. During the call she will explain the service, the interview process and follow-up. Be open about your preferences, expectations, and any specific needs or concerns you may have regarding your pregnancy, labor, and postpartum period. This information will help Tara suggest the best Doula fit for you.
- After discussing your needs, Tara will connect you with at least two Doulas
 who meet your criteria. These interviews can be set up virtually or in-person.
 Here is a suggested list of <u>questions to ask a prospective Doula.</u>
- After the interviews Tara will follow up to hear your thoughts on moving forward with any candidates and next steps. She will discuss contracts and payment arrangements.

Do I have to be High Risk to work with a Specialized Birth Doula?

No, you do not need to be considered high risk to work with specialized Birth Doulas. Our services are designed to support a range of clients, including those with medically complex situations as well as those who simply desire the expertise and support of our most experienced Birth Doulas. Whether you have specific medical concerns or just want additional support during your birth experience, we are here to assist you.

Does Birthing Gently work in teams or on an on-call schedule?

No! While you may find many other Birth Doula's, agencies or collaboratives in the community who work in this way, we don't.

Birthing Gently does not operate on a team or on-call schedule. Instead, we prioritize individualized 1:1 care and the traditional practice of a Birth Doula, ensuring that families receive personal attention rather than a high-volume service model.

While there's a minimal chance of needing backup support, the agency aims to provide consistent care from a dedicated Birth Doula.

Do you work with employer benefits, insurance or FSA?

Absolutely! During the intake phone call, I'll make sure to specify that we have a specific Doula who meets the criteria for all three areas of support. This will help us

provide you with the best possible match. If there are any other details or preferences you'd like us to keep in mind, please let me know!

Our Doula's do not speak on your behalf. We help you with self advocacy through prenatal discussion. Doula's will prompt you to ask the right questions about your care and encourage you to **B.R.A.I.N.** (Benefits, Risks, Alternatives, Intuition, and Nothing) it out! Their goal is to create a positive birth experience that respects the wishes of the birthing person while also maintaining a cooperative dynamic with healthcare providers.

Can we choose the same Birth Doula and Posptartum Doula for continuity?

We have several Doulas who provide both Birth and Postpartum Doula care. Depending on location, type of postpartum support needed (day or overnight) it is possible to have the same Doula for both services. Please keep in mind these Doulas book in advance so availability is limited.
